The cash settlement is based on a seven-day average of cash market prices for feeder steers in 27 states, calculated by Cattle Fax, a nonprofit Colorado corporation that provides information to cattle producers.

CSI will use this price as the cash price for CSI Feeder Cattle, #33, beginning May 1, 1986.

Users should be back on line in about one week. Due to an exchange line format change, we had to suspend our QUICKQUOTE service. The format change and numerous suggestions from users on how to improve

this service were two matters address simultaneously. The new product should b vastly improved and the scope of coverag will be increased.
