WHAT'S NEW ---

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COMPUNET INCREASES PORTS

Due to the widespread acceptance of our COMPUNET telephone network, CSI has made additional 1200 baud ports available for your convenience. Customers who recently received a copy of QUICKTRIEVE® through CSI's free software offer, had their software parameters preset to logon to our mainframe with COMPUNET. The immediate enthusiastic response by our customer base to take advantage of this offer, and the subsequent abundance of users utilizing the existing COMPUNET ports, quickly brought their use to maximum capacity. It is in response to this need that CSI has increased its COMPUNET caller capacity. In the future, CSI will continue to respond to our customers needs.

A temporary network communication loss was experienced during the middle of the week ending June 24 that affected Compunet users. Workers at a construction site in Miami severed a communication line that prohibited some European and domestic QUICKTRIEVE users from collecting their data. Many other local services were affected. The line has been repaired and no further inconvenience should be experienced. Virtually all of the unsuccessful logon attempts experienced during this time period were attributable to this unfortunate accident.

HELPFUL LOGON HINTS

Here are some helpful hints that may better inform you when experiencing minor difficulties in logging on. Usually, the problem is simple to correct with little time consumption involved. There are a few cases, however, that do require help from the CUSTOMER SERVICE DEPARTMENT. Some messages displayed on the CRT screen during the routine logon procedure are described as follows:

1) "REJECTING..." This is an indication that all telecommunication ports are occupied or that possibly the CSI mainframe computer is temporarily off-line. An immediate recall will usually produce a successful logon. If not, wait 5 minutes and try again or access a different network.

2) "SYSTEM TIMEOUT..." This error can be caused by various inconsistencies with the routine logon procedure. A few items that the Quicktrieve user may check for possible error are:

- a) Incorrect area code (for long-distance callers). CSI's area code has been changed to 407.
- b) When collecting for a full-week on any Monday, specify PAS1 as the week selected for collection.
- c) Check for possible line communication interruption from call-waiting prompt or extension phone being picked up during logon procedure.
- d) Your local telephone connection may have disconnected during the logon procedure.
- e) The CSI mainframe may be temporarily off-line. A phone call to the CUSTOMER SERVICE DEPARTMENT will verify whether or not this is the cause of the error message.

If all the afore-mentioned possibilities have been ruled out, please allow our CUSTOMER SERVICE DEPARTMENT to assist you.

NOTES FROM MARKETING

Price decrease announcement: Effective August 1, 1988 CSI's historical data prices on securities and mutual funds will be reduced for diskettes and data accessed via long distance or Compunet after 6:00 PM caller's local time. This decrease cuts the price we previously charged and now makes our prices as low or lower than just about all of our competitors.

Any history order of stocks or mutual funds is now subject to a minimum of six data months per contract. We no longer charge a set-up fee for stocks. History on disk orders remain subject to a \$50 minimum.

For example an exchange quote of 97-095 which means 97 and 9.5 thirty seconds would be expressed as 9719 or 97 and 19 sixty fourths in CSI's data base. We prefer a meaningful algebraic representation instead of the exchanges clumsy procedure.

The following errors were found after the data was first released. They may or may not affect a user depending upon the time of access. The figures in bold print represent the corrected values. The total and individual volume and open interest are presented in raw form ready for input into your IBM computer. The scientific notation requirement of QUICKTRIEVE would require a raw open interest value of 294070, for example, to be stored as 129407. A volume or open interest of magnitude 99999 or less requires no adjustment.
